S&H Campground Guidelines RVs • Tents • Cabins • Trailers

Registration: Law requires all campers to register before occupying a camping space.

Visitors: Any visitors you have at the campground must register and pay applicable fees before entering the camping area. If you prefer, you may pre-pay your visitor's fees but they must still register with the office. Daily visitors must leave the campground by 10:30pm or they will be responsible for paying the overnight camping rate.

Speed Limit: For everyone's safety, please obey the 5 MPH speed limit.

Children: Parents are responsible for their children and their safety. Do not leave your children unattended.

Pets: This is a pet friendly campground however we do require that you use a leash. Pet owners are responsible for properly disposing of their pets feces. No pets are allowed in the lake, pool, cabins or trailers. Please do not leave your pet unattended on the grounds.

Alcohol: Please keep all alcoholic beverages on your site. Alcohol is not permitted around the playgrounds, lake, or pool.

Pool: No lifeguard is on duty, swim at your own risk. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult or they will be asked to leave. Parents are responsible for their children. There shall be no cutoff shorts, pets, food, drinks, smoking, running, and/or jumping in the pool.

Fishing: No license required for the lake. License required in creek if you are over 16 years old. Wardens watch closely and the fines are heavy for violators. Fishing from bridge is prohibited. There is a 3 fish limit. All fishing stops at 10:30pm.

Security: Display sticker or camping pass in your windshield. For your security, all vehicles without a sticker or pass will be stopped.

Quiet Hours: Please be considerate of your neighbors and observe the quiet hours of 10:00pm to 8:00am.

Check Out: Cabin occupants are to check out with the office by 11:00am. All campers are to be checked out by 11:00am. If you would like to extend your stay with us, please let us know as soon as possible.

Bathrooms: Everyone likes a clean bathroom, please help us to keep it that way. All children under 8 should be accompanied by an adult. NO washing of clothes or dishes in the bathrooms.

Clothes Lines: Clothes lines are not permitted.

Laundry Facilities: Laundry facilities are located behind the pool side cafe.

Dumpsters: Do not leave trash on the ground or put trash on top of dumpsters. Please respect our land and properly dispose of trash in the dumpsters provided.

Vehicles: Each campsite is allowed 1 vehicle. Washing or repairing vehicles on your campsite is prohibited.

Trees: Do not chop or cut any trees or shrubs, violators will be fined. We have firewood for sale at the office.

For everyone's protection, the following things are prohibited on the grounds.

Gray Water: State Law prohibits draining of gray water onto the ground or in the lake or creek. Please use a bucket and empty at the dump station.

Fireworks: Display or use of fireworks by campers is not permitted.

Firearms: Firearms or other weapons are not permitted on the grounds.

Equipment: Campground equipment is not to be removed from the grounds. Tampering or adjusting park equipment, utilities, or facilities are not permitted.

Trees/Wildlife: Removal of trees, shrubs, seedlings, or plants is not permitted. Hunting is not permitted.

Digging: Digging and/or the use of metal detectors are not permitted.

Soliciting: Soliciting of any kind is not permitted on the grounds.

Entrance onto the Campground property constitutes permission for the management of S&H Campground to photograph the visitor while on the premises and to use any resulting pictures for any lawful purpose without compensation to the visitor. The guest assumes all risks and danger incidental to the activity of camping in a rustic outdoors environment, including specifically (but not exclusively) the danger of being injured by insects or other animals, injured while participating in recreating activities (such as hiking, swimming, and boating), or injured as a result of inclement weather conditions, and agrees that the Campground and its owners, agents, and employees are not liable for injuries or property damages, due to resulting in such causes. Owners, agents and employees will not be responsible for theft of property while visiting the Campground.

You are responsible for any damages that are incurred during your stay at S&H Campground. If damages exceed the deposit amount, your credit card will be charged the remaining amount. You will be notified of such charges.
